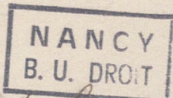

But at 135 the copyist has made
a blunder. The figures of both list &
fables agree (as I have corrected them), down
to 135, De conjugio fideliter &c. In the
list, De virginitate has no ~~2~~ number, the forgot
it in both body & list. In the body
quod que volunt is 137 & in the list 136.
In the body De virginitate is 138, and
in the list also 138. For the list omits
the number 137 altogether.

The list also omits the numbers
142, 143, 144, but continues with 145,
146 quite correctly. The body omits
no. 140 but continues with 141 rightly
so that both end with 145, 146 agreeing.

Will you then alter your note & set it right
from 135 to 138. I pencil in the following noo.
